

Notice of Race (NOR)

- The Laser Class European Event Series 2021-

Organised by Univela Campione del Garda, Brescia, Italia under the auspices of the The Laser Class

17th - 19th September 2021

Campione del Garda, Brescia, Italy

The races activities will be carried out in accordance with the provisions for dealing with COVID-19 virus as set out by the Italian Sailing Federation (FIV) and implemented by the organizing committee. All participants must comply with these measures as supervised by the organizing committee. Any case or suspected case of COVID-19 during the event must be reported without delay to the organizing committee and the local health authorities respectively.

Additional information provided by the organizing authority, the Italian Sailing Federation or any other relevant authority after the publication of this Notice of Race (NoR) must be adhered to. In particular, the Italian Sailing Federation protocols for yacht clubs and associations referring to the containment of the COVID-19 virus.

1. Rules

- 1.1 Each regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the "The Racing Rules of Sailing ("RRS") set out by World Sailing and supersedes any National Authority guidelines.
- 1.2 Sails shall be marked with the relevant 3-letter National country code and the full boat number in accordance with The Laser Class by-laws and the RRS. Exceptions must receive a written approval by the organizing committee.
- 1.3 Appendix T of the RRS will be used to resolve any disputes. For interpretation of the RRS the English text will take precedence. Protest hearings will be heard in English.
- 1.4 Every sailor shall have the requisite sailing license and sailing skills required for participation in this sailing regatta.
- 1.5 This Notice of Race may be subject to amendments which will be identified in the Notice of Race addendum and noted on the TLC website and posted by the organizer. Additional information will be published by The Laser Class on its website or by the host sailing club/venue



2. Sailing Instructions

- 2.1 The sailing instructions will be available after 15th of September 2021 from 12:00 CET
- 2.2 Sailing instructions will consist of the instructions found in Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and the supplementary sailing instructions that will be available at the race office and published on the TLC website prior to the event at the latest on the 16th of September 2021 from 12:00 CET

3. Communication

- 3.1 The online official notice board is located at https://www.campioneunivela.it/en/regattas/2021/the-laser-class-european-event-series-2021/ and https://www.thelaserclass.com/event/the-laser-class-regatta-univela/
- 3.2 A boat shall neither make radio communication while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

4. Eligibility & Entry

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Laser Class(es) with 4.7, Radial & Standard rigs. A list of eligible class hull plaques is listed in the TLC Class rules.
- 4.2 The minimum age requirement is twelve (12) years on or before the date of the regatta.
- 4.3 Only current members of The Laser Class ("TLC") are eligible to register for the regatta. All registrations must be made directly on the class website: www.thelaserclass.com/events/
- 4.4 Non-members at the time of registration can automatically register electronically as a member of TLC by using the dedicated membership form: www.thelaserclass.com/registration/
- 4.5 Registered entrants must have completed their registration by signing in to the organizers at the venue. Entrants failing to do so will be neither listed nor scored in the event.

5. Entry Fees

- 5.1 The entry fee for 4.7, Radial and Standard rigs is 100€. To be paid within the 5th of September
- 5.2 Entrants with an age of 16 or under on the 1st day of the regatta are eligible for 10% reduction in the entry fee. This reduction does not apply to the late entry fee.
- 5.3 The late entry fee will be 40 €
- 5.4 Non-payment of the entry fees after the closing date of the registration will automatically cancel the regatta registration.



- 5.5 Cancellation policy:
 - (a) Entrants cancelling their registration prior 14 days before the first race day will receive a full refund.
 - (b) Entrants cancelling within 14 days before the first race will not be refunded.
- 5.6 In case that an event is postponed or canceled by the Organizing Authority under force majeure, the registration fee will be refunded with an administration charge of 10% of the registration fee. In case of a competitor/entrant no show or in any other circumstance, the registration fee is non-refundable.
- 5.7 Entrants/Competitors that are minors must present a letter of consent signed by the parent, guardian or "Support Person" that allows them to comply with the Rules (RRS 3.1 (b)) and who, during the event, takes sole responsibility for minors that are racing as competitors.

6. Crew Limitations

6.1 Crew substitution is not permitted as follows; "only one person shall be on board whilst racing. The person shall be named on the registration form".

7. Advertising

- 7.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen by the organizer.
- 7.2 TLC or the organizers may provide bibs that entrants are required to wear and make visible to the organizers.
- 7.2 Photography Consent: By entering the regatta, entrants accept that they may be photographed and/or videotaped participating in the race and/or using the regatta facilities and they consent to the taking of such images and to the use, reuse, publication and republication of such images in any media, in conjunction with the competitor's name or not, without compensation and without the competitor's approval of such images or any use thereof.

8. Qualifying Series & Final Series

8.1 If any fleet has a large number of entries, the Organizing Authority may also decide to divide that fleet, Divided fleets will sail a qualifying series prior to being split into Gold/Silver final series.

9. Schedule

- 9.1 Competitors shall register and complete payment online via The Laser Class website https://www.thelaserclass.com/event/univela before 5th of September at 23.59 CET
- 9.2 Registration will open at 12.00 CET on 1st of March
- 9.3 No more than three races per fleet will be scheduled for each day, excepting if fewer than three races have been completed on a prior race day, then a fourth race may be attempted. Furthermore, the Organizing Authority may decide to attempt a fourth race on any day, provided, however, that the regatta will never be more than one race ahead of schedule.

A maximum of nine (9) races, in total, are scheduled for the entire regatta.

- 9.5 The time of the first warning signal for Sunday will be notified to competitors with a notice that will be displayed online/on the Official Notice Board by 19:00 CET of the day before the day in which it will take effect. In case the notice is not displayed, the time scheduled in 9.4 will be effective.
- 9.6 On the last day of the regatta no warning signal will be made after 16:00 CET

10. Equipment Inspection

- 10.1 Each boat shall display a valid class plaque. The Laser Class, its representatives, assigned race committees or organizers are entitled to inspect boats and equipment so as to ensure compliance with the TLC Class Rules before, during or after any regatta or practice days.
- 10.2 All entrants must use only one hull, sail, mast bottom section, mast top section, centre-board and rudder according to The Laser Class Rules. The Laser Class Rules are available to all entrants as a pdf. document: www.thelaserclass.com/documents/
- 10.3 In the event of damage, boats and equipment may only be substituted with the written permission of the equipment inspector, Jury or Race Committee.
- 10.4 If the damage occurs later than 90 minutes before the first scheduled start on a racing day and before the start of the last race of the day, provisional verbal permission shall be obtained from the equipment inspector, Jury or Race Committee and the written permission of the Equipment inspector, Jury or Race Committee shall be applied for before the end of protest time at the end of the day in which the substitution takes place.

11. Clothing and Equipment

- 11.1 An entrants clothing and equipment shall not weigh more than the number of kilograms as permitted by the RRS 50.1(b)
- 11.2 Competitors shall wear personal flotation devices at all times when afloat, except briefly when changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment.



Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices. This changes rule RRS 40.

12. Venue

- 12.1 NoR attachment A shows the plan of the event venue
- 12.2 NoR attachment B shows the location of the racing areas

13. Courses

13.1 The Organizing Authority will define the racing areas according to the conditions and assigned fleets.

14. Penalty System

- 14.1 Appendix P "Special Procedures for Rule 42" will apply with changes to include: allowing a jury initiated redress, points penalty for a first penalty given after finishing and to prohibit a boat that has been disqualified for a rule 42 infringement or has retired in recognition of a rule 42 infringement from sailing in the race if that race is re-started or re-sailed.
- 14.2 For protests where only a rule of Part 2 is alleged to have been broken, an arbitration hearing may be offered prior to any formal protest hearing.
- 14.3 An international jury may be appointed in accordance with RRS Appendix N and perform the duties listed in RRS Appendix N2. Their decisions will be final as provided in rule 70.5 RRS.
- 14.4 Competitors shall comply with rule 5 and ISAF Regulation 21 Anti-Doping Rule and Anti-Doping Code, which ban the use of drugs. Drugs testing may take place during the event.

15. Scoring

- 15.1 The Low-Point Scoring System (RRS Appendix A) will apply. A minimum of one (1) completed race is required to validate the individual regatta.
- 15.2 Four races are required to constitute a series. Therefore, when;
 - fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boats series score will be the sum of her race scores
 - 5,6,7 or 8 races have been completed, a boats series score will be the sum of her race scores excluding her worst score
 - 9 or more races have been completed, a boats series score will be the sum of her race scores excluding her two worst scores
- 15.3 If a points scoring penalty would result in a score worse than DSQ, the penalty will be that corresponding to DSQ. The scores of other boats will not be changed.
- 15.4 There will be separate rankings for each category as defined in §22
- 15.5 It will be by extraction for each age category from the overall position in the Laser Standard fleet and Laser Radial fleet unless there is more than one



start in the Laser Standard or Laser Radial fleets when the ranking will be extracted from the overall position in the starting fleet.

15.6 A separate ranking will be extracted from each age category for the Laser Radial women. The Radial Legend Masters (75 & Over) result will be determined by the series score in the combined Great Grand Master and Radial Legend Master fleet. (Note: This result will be extracted from the overall result and published without recalculation.). The fleet rankings are for information only (no overall winners of the Standard or Radial fleet).

16. Support Person Vessels

16.1 Support Persons may register online:

Payment made at the event venue at registration shall be by card only and Euros only.

The Support Person's Fee for registration is 50 euros.

A registration is not valid until paid.

The following documentation shall be brought to the event Race Office before the First Race:

Proof of valid third party liability Insurance.

Boat driving license (if applicable).

17. Charter or Loaned Boats

17.1 LaserPerformance will supply a limited number of charter boats for this event. Charters will be allocated to sailors based on order requests.

The boats will be Laser XD models, supplied on a launching trolley, XD padded hiking strap, spars (carbon mast top section, appropriate bottom section, and a boom).

Sailors must provide their own control line deck block fitting with blocks and control line deck fitting for use during the regatta.

17.2 Chartered or loaned boat may carry national letters or a sail number in contravention of her class rules, provide that the race committee has approved her before the first race.

18. Accommodation

18.1 Competitors shall make their own housing arrangements.

Competitors can book rooms or apartments at Campione Univela Hostel https://www.campioneunivela.it/ospitalita/. Mentioning the participation to the regatta during the booking process will grant the "regatta" discount.

The building and the beach area are a unitary complex for accommodation purposes and equipment for leisure and sports services, where all sailors can find:

19. Data Protection

19.1 Where applicable, all data will be handled in accordance with European data protection regulations.

20. Indemnification

20.1 To the fullest extent permitted by law, each entrant/competitor/participant agrees to indemnify and hold the Univela Sailing, The Laser Class, owners, affiliates, officers, employees, agents, committee persons and race officials acting in their official capacities harmless, from any third party claim to the extent arising from a competitor's acts or omissions.

21. Liability & Insurance

- 21.1 Univela Sailing, The Laser Class, their officers, members and volunteers do not accept liability for loss of life or property, personal injury or damage caused by or arising out of the regatta.
- 21.2 All those taking part in an event do so at their own risk and responsibility. Attention is drawn to the RRS Fundamental Rule 4 Decision to Race, which states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone"



- 21.3 The establishment of the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions in no way limits or reduces the complete and unlimited responsibilities of a competitor being solely and entirely responsible for the management of a boat he or she is sailing. A competitor shall maintain their boat in a safe and seaworthy condition.
- 21.4 An entrant is wholly and exclusively responsible for third party liability insurance on the boat that he or she is sailing and for his or her personal accident and health insurance.
- 21.5 All entrants shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of €1,500,000 (1.5 million Euros) per event or equivalent thereof in any other currency.

22. Prizes

22.1 Entrants will be ranked in each category. Prizes will be given in the following categories:

Standard Fleet:

Laser Boys/Men (12 to 19 years), (under 21 years) & (21 years and older)

Laser Apprentice Standard (35 to 44 years)

Laser Master Standard (45 to 54 years)

Laser Grand Master Standard (55 to 64 years)

Laser Great Grand Master Standard Men (from 65)

22.2 Laser Radial Fleet

Laser Girls/Ladies (12 to 16 years), (17 to 19 years), (under 21 years) & (21 years and older)

Laser Boys/Men (12 to 17 years), (18 to 19 years) & (19 years and over)

Laser Apprentice Radial Men (35 to 44 years)

Laser Apprentice Radial Women (35 to 44 years)

Laser Master Radial Men (45 to 54 years)

Laser Master Radial Women (45 to 54 years)

Laser Grand Master Radial Men (55 to 64 years)

Laser Grand Master Radial Women (55 to 64 years)

Laser Great Grand Master Radial Men (from 65)

 - more than 11 entrants: 3 prizes per category


